Notes for the Guidance of Applicants

1. Travel grants are available to sportspersons who are residents of the Mana Community Grants Foundation designated area and are selected by the National Sports Body to represent New Zealand. The funds can only be applied to overseas airfares.
2. The amount granted for NZ representatives are as follows:

\$700	for travel to Australia and South Pacific Islands; and
\$1,500	for travel beyond Australia/Pacific Islands
3. Grants are available once every three years.
4. Guidelines for the distribution of gaming machine profits are specified by the Gaming Division of the Department of Internal Affairs and must be observed by the Foundation.
5. One of them is that a grant to a sportsperson cannot be made directly to him/her but must be made to, and be administered by, an incorporated body to which the applicant is affiliated. See Clause 3 of the Declaration.
6. Your Club will be notified if your grant application is approved by the Foundation.
7. Trust Porirua is the principal sponsor/organiser of Annual Sportsperson of the Year Awards which are made to an Individual, a Young Achiever (under 19 years of age), to a Team. From the winners of those awards there will be chosen a Porirua Sportsperson of the Year.
8. As a person selected as a New Zealand representative the Trust is of the view that you should be worthy of nomination of one of the Awards. Your club will be encouraged to make such a nomination, with your consent.
